This course introduces students to the mushroom flora of SE Alaska. Focus will be on the use of taxonomic keys for identification of fungi and recognition of both edible and poisonous mushrooms. Cooking and preservation of mushrooms will be discussed. Field trips will be followed by in-class identification of collected mushrooms.
