## Harmful Algal Bloom Advisory:

The Southeast Alaska Tribal Toxins (SEATT) partnership has been collecting phytoplankton samples throughout southeast Alaska to monitor for plankton species that can produce toxins and cause human health effects, specifically paralytic shellfish poisoning (PSP). Recent samples on 6/1/2016 confirmed elevated levels of *Alexandrium*, the phytoplankton species that produces saxtoxins causing PSP, has been observed at the following locations and shellfish from these sites should not be harvested at this time.
