Shellfish Advisory:

The Sitka Tribe of Alaska Environmental Research Lab (STAERL) has been collecting shellfish samples to test for biotoxins, specifically paralytic shellfish poisoning (PSP). Recent samples on May 25, 2016 confirm that clams at the following beaches have elevated levels of toxins above the FDA regulatory limit of 80ug/100g and should not be harvested at this time.
