HOW IT WORKS



We catch the fish.

Our fish comes from **local fishermen and processors**. They are individually landed, gilled and chilled within minutes of leaving the ocean. They are then processed at a Sitka based processing facility into conveniently sized, vacuum-packed frozen fillets.

We deliver, you pick up.

In each CSF city (Sitka, Juneau, Fairbanks, Anchorage, and Seattle), a program coordinator distributes fish at a predetermined pickup location to subscribers on a given range of days each month.

For sales over 40 lbs, we will ship custom orders of fish to individuals anywhere in the US.

We support fishery conservation work.

All profits support the **Fishery Conservation Network**, which engages fishermen in research and conservation initiatives. With fishermen-generated ideas, we design tools that assist the fleet in mentoring other fishermen and improving fishing practices.
